- Perform environmental audits to ensure compliance with environmental requirements

The core objectives of the EMS are to:

- Continually improve environmental performance by establishing objectives and targets and regularly reviewing progress in meeting these
- Avoid, reduce and control the creation, emission or discharge of any type of pollutant or waste, in order to reduce the adverse environmental aspects

With regard to these core objectives Folknoll will:

- a) Minimize waste and ensure it is reused, recycled or properly disposed of in an environmentally acceptable manner
- b) Make efficient use of energy, water and other resources
- c) Reduce the consumption of raw material, minimize the use of environmental sensitive materials and promote the use of recycled materials wherever possible
- d) Work with major suppliers, contractors and customers to assist in their environmental performance improvement
- e) Minimize any disturbance to the local and global environment and to the quality of life of the local communities in which the company operates
- f) Assess the environmental effects of new plant, processes and developments
- g) Provide the information necessary to enable the company's products to be properly used, stored and disposed of so to avoid unacceptable effects on man or the environment
- h) Provide the necessary information to enable employees to operate the processes properly and with minimum effects on man or the environment.
